- 2. Apprenticeship Information Packet you keep this for your information.

### You will also need to obtain the following required documentation

- 1. Original Birth Certificate
- 2. Original High School Diploma or GED
- 3. Passport Photo of yourself for us to keep in your file we do not need an actual passport, only the photo. You can get those done at any CVS, Walgreens and/or Post Office.
- 4. Valid Driver's License and Vehicle Registration Card
- 5. Reference Letter from current or former employer
- 6. Official High School Transcripts <u>DO NOT OPEN</u> We must have the transcript even if you did not complete high school.
- 7. Original DD-214 Discharge Papers if you have ever been in the service
- 8. Original Social Security Card

#### INFORMATION ON THE OPERATING ENGINEERS APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

#### 1. Who sponsors the Apprenticeship Program?

Operating Engineers Local Union 37 & The Maryland Heavy & Highway Contractors Association.

#### 2. What is the cost involved in participating in the Apprenticeship Program?

There is no charge to the applicant (if selected for training) other than the fees that the MVA charges when you get your CDL License and the fees that the NCCCO charges when you get your CCO Certification.

3. How long does it take to complete the program, and when does it begin?

It takes three (3) years to complete the program, and the program begins June 1 of

#### 4. Where will I attend field training?

each year.

Field training is being held at the Operating Engineers Local 37 Training School located at 5021 North Point Blvd. Sparrows Point, MD 21219.

#### 5. What time is field training held?

The hands-on field training is done for one week, Monday–Friday, from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm, once every three (3) months on average.

#### 6. Where will I be working?

You will be employed by one of the participating contractors who are signatories to an agreement with the local union. You may be working in Baltimore City or the surrounding counties.

## 7. What type of work will I be performing?

Operating Engineers operate and maintain heavy construction equipment on construction projects. In the beginning, you will be working as an oiler, mechanic's helper, or other entry-level jobs, working with heavy equipment.

#### 8. What is the starting pay?

The starting pay is \$21.00 per hour plus a fringe benefit package after qualifying. Apprentices receive a pay increase after every 750 hours of on-the-job training are completed. After graduation, the apprentice will go from the 6<sup>th</sup> pay period to a journeyperson's rate.

- 9. How do I apply for the Operating Engineers Local 37 Apprenticeship Program? Come by the training school between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm, Monday—Friday, and pick up an application, or you can print the application by visiting our website at Training37.com and clicking the yellow button on the left-hand side of the home page that says, "get an application."
- 10. What steps are involved to have my application processed for training and what are the requirements?

You must be 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or GED. The steps to be selected for training are:

- \*\* Complete the application packet.
- \*\* Furnish a birth certificate, high school transcript, high school diploma or GED certificate, passport photo, driver's license, vehicle registration card, social security card, and reference letter. #### 11. How are apprentices selected?

Apprentices are selected on a non-discriminatory basis. Job opportunities dictate the number of applicants selected each year.
